- 1 in 4 children of school-going age is out of school in India, with around 99 million children in total who have dropped out of school.
- Out of every 100 children, only 32 children finish their school education age-appropriately.
- There are 10.13 million child labourers between the ages of 5 and 14 years in India.
- India has 33 million working children between the ages of 5 and 18 years. In parts of the country, more than half the child population is engaged in child labour.

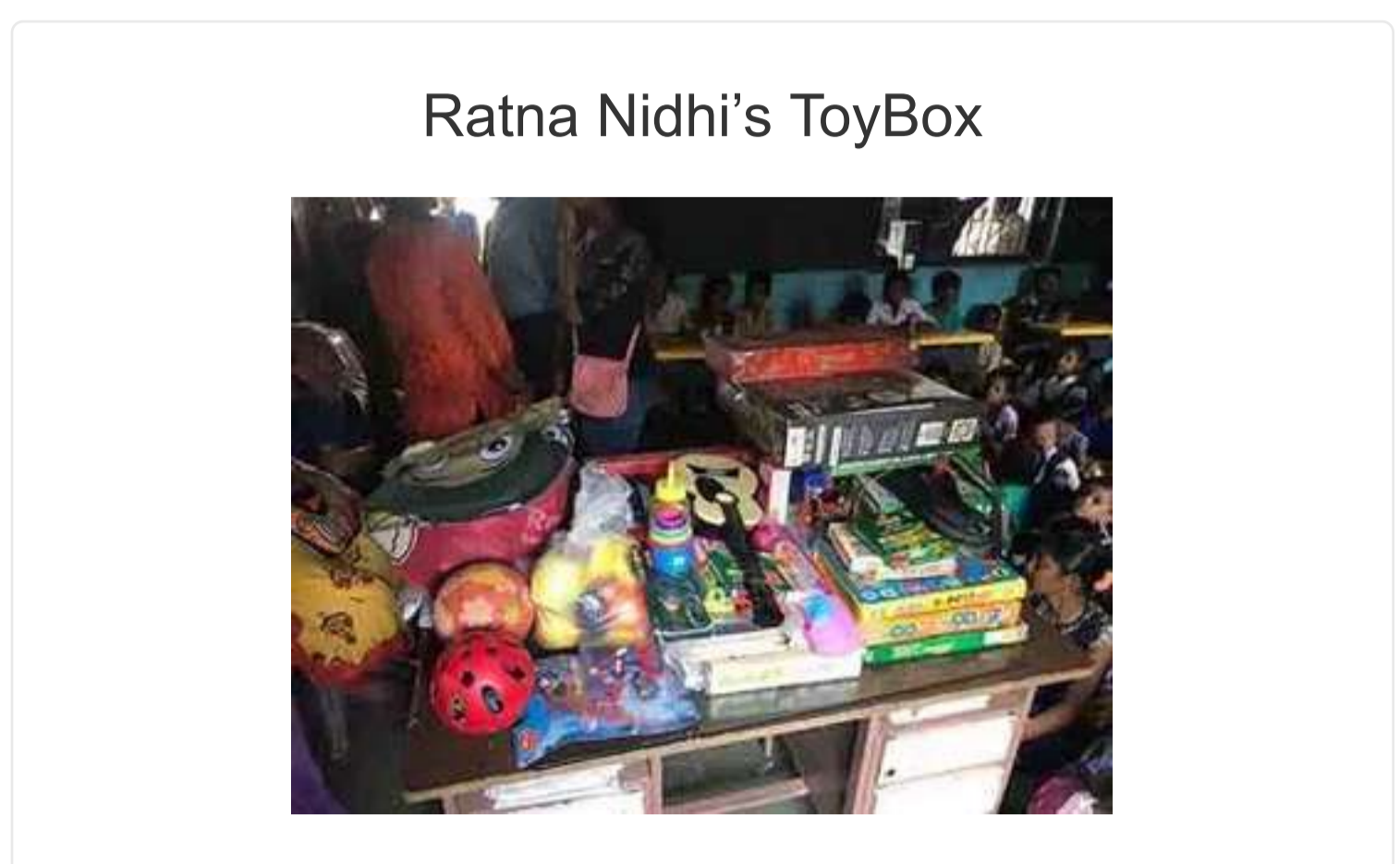
What happens to these children?
